Relevant info: current symptoms: fatigue, malaise, suppressed immunity.

Dental history: first amalgams placed in early teens, at the most had maybe ten, which tended to fall out and be replaced. Had amalgams for twenty five years, and numerous root fillings. Developed long-term dental and bone infections, recently this led to surgery and most of my teeth being removed. No more root canals in, and I think no metal. There are two crowns left that haven't been lifted recently. The removal of my amalgam, including metal posts, was done unsafely.

Mother's dental history - long-term presence of several amalgams.

Vaccinations - flu, Hep B/A.

Long-term antibiotic therapy in the months leading up to the test due to kidney disease and frequent UTI's. Also liothyronnine.

I have also used supplements with lithium in them, and collodial silver.

Location: various part of the UK and South Western US.

Co-morbid conditions: Meduallary Sponge Kidney, ME, Lyme and Babseia, Blastocytosis, Severe Osteoporosis, KPU/HPU. Also treated for Hep C - a year on three shots of interferon alpha a week and daily ribavirin.
