#### 1) What are your current symptoms and health history?

#### l'ma 36 year male.

Depressed symptoms on and off for over ten years, intermittent swelling of glands in the throat that the military GPs can't diagnose (repeatedly offer antibiotics), cold hands and feet, mood swings, dark thoughts (RAF referred me to CBT Therapy - ineffective - depression not root cause of symptoms). Low libido, lethargic, fatigued (especially post exercise), impatient, short tempered, intolerant, irritable, over-sleeping, no joy for past pursuits, bad head scratching/dan-druff.

# 2) Dental history (wisdom teeth removed? First root canal placed? Braces? First amalgam etc...)

Sorry - I have had a total of 12 amalgams fitted in the last 25 years, one being a root canal, post and crown (and various vaccines) but I don't have my military dental records. This hair test was taken as a bench test whilst the amalgams were still in my mouth, before amalgam removal and restoration. Post this hair test; I have had all amalgams removed (under a safe amalgam extraction protocol), and the metal post & crown. All now composites or ceramics.
