## Health history for hair test 205

- 1). Current symptoms: severe adrenal fatigue (very low blood pressure, 40 lb weight loss in 5 months, diarrhea, etc), cortisol levels low-normal, low estrogen, even lower progesterone (making me estrogen dominant). Muscle trembling, pain, twitching, insomnia, extreme fatigue, clumsiness. Peripheral neuropathy since age 33.
- 2). Country of origin-Czechoslovakia. Amalgam fillings (at least 3-5) put in sometime during pre-adolescence and adolescent years. 1993-at least one amalgam filling replaced with white composite filling. 3 wisdom teeth removed. All during pregnancy (in US). Last wisdom tooth removed in 2003 with partial root left in due to inaccessibility (and most likely due to poor experience of the dentist, not done by surgeon). 2003-2006 two amalgam filling removed and teeth crowned. 2006 one amalgam filling removed, root canal and crown done on that tooth. All amalgam removal was done the 'traditional' way, no protection.

  One remaining molar with amalgam filling still in.
- 3). Due to current medical issues-unable to drive or handle any kind of stress (cannot tolerate loud noises, fast movements). Dental cleanup not done yet.
- 4) Mother-I'm sure she had amalgam fillings put it before I was born, don't know further details.
- 5). One flue shot years ago, last vaccination in 1995 for tetanus.
- 6). Supplements: started taking only a few weeks ago (4-5). C 3g, B-100 3 tablets, zinc 50 mg, B6 200mg, CoQ10 100mg, Acetyl-L-Carnitine 500 mg, Mg 400 mg, Ca 300mg (every other day), flax oil, fish oil, chromium picolinate 600 mg. A few days before the test, I believe I started taking adrenal rebuilder from <a href="https://www.adrenalfatigue.org">www.adrenalfatigue.org</a> (but don't see much improvement yet).
- 7). I am puzzled over high Arsenic, I do not know what the source may be other than I walk barefoot on our hardwood floors. This house was built in 1995. Can it be from wood preservative?
- Also, I am quite worried about high Uranium. All I can think of is Chernobyl disaster in 1986. I was barely 15 when it happened and the radiation was detected throughtout the whole Europe. How do I deal with this? Chelators for radioactive elements?
