## **Health history for hair test 250**

- 1) Lyme Disease, Bartonella dx 9-17-08. Slowly improving severe gastrointestinal dysfunction. Severe malabsorption/underweight. 4'10/63 lbs. Has struggled with being underweight all his life. Hypoglycemia. Severe Multiple Chemical Sensitivity began 8 months ago. Neurally Mediated Hypotension. Small Hiatal Hernia dx in July 08. Tick, mosquito, mold exposure.
- \*HLA DRB DBQ results: 4-3-53 (multisusceptible to biotoxins) 7-2/3-53 (susceptible to mold toxins). Body does not recognize these toxins and recirculates them repeatedly instead of sending them "out" via bile, fecal elimination.
- 2) Chronic Intractable Nausea: daily misery. Gallbladder/Liver congestion/sludging. Pancreatic Enzyme Amylase creeping out of the high end of normal.
- 3) No dental amalgams.
- 4) Mother had one very small amalgam. Removed properly but son was four months old, still breastfeeding. Son breast fed for two years.
- 5) Mother's hair analysis twenty years ago: very high mercury/copper. Mother was a professional photographer. Major exposure to developer chemicals: silver....from print developing baths. Did not always wear gloves during college years. Mother asymptomatic.
- 6) No autism. NO vaccinations. No antibiotics. No Rx except the anaesthesia used in hospital for upper endoscopy/lower signmoidoscopy in July 08. Mother was globetrotter. Has been vaccinated for everything under the blazing sun. Nearly died from Typhoid vaccine.
- 7) Son lived 5 years in Florida on our farm. No agriculture. No industry. Farm has horse fencing: uses arsenic/pressure treated wood. Son has eaten red snapper, grouper in Florida. No other known mercury containing fish.
- 8) Have always lived in remote rural horse country. Never in large cities. Wells always tested, shown to be safe.
- 9) Drank Crystal Geyser water for three months in end of 07...reputed to have higher levels of arsenic.
- 10) Supplements: Tanalbit, magnesium, calcium, CoQ10, B complex, Licorice, Boluoke, E, Ester C, Lyme Transfer Factor, stopped supplementing zinc....need to recommence? Need chromium polynicotinate?????
- 11) Currently in Arizona in remote area with no agriculture or industry. Having spring water tested. Arrowhead and natural spring where many residents here get their water in a remote canyon. Reputed to be tested monthly and deemed safe.
