Health history for hair test 368 for TEI test in 1997

I came across this TEI hair test from 1997.

It appears to easily match Cutler's Counting Rule #3 with 6 of the relevant elements at the extreme top or bottom of the graph (cf. Hair Test Interpretation p. 271). The test also appears to have a very strong adrenal sign. My 1997 adrenal and thyroid symptoms accurately match Cutler's description. (cf. HTI p. 113)

Symptoms and health history at the time of the test:

In 1997 PTSD (post traumatic stress syndrome) was a limiting factor in my life. I was not working and was not very functional. I was very sensitive to stressful situations.

I was eating a good diet and was taking quite a few supplements; however I don't have a list of them.

Prior to the hair test I was taking synthroid, maybe 30-40mg, but it was not working. Shortly after taking the test, I started taking Armour thyroid medicine. As a result, my weight dropped nearly 20 lbs to a healthy level. I had more energy. (Note: I've continued to take Armour with good results to the present time-- Fall 2011.)

What dental work do you currently have in place? What part of the dental clean-up have you completed?

At the time of this test 5 amalgams were still were still present since my teens. (Note: all amalgam was removed safely Fall 2011)

Health history for hair test 368

1. What are your current symptoms and health history?

Was a rather healthy and energetic youth but slow to learn some subjects due to mild ADD. Additional problems started in early twenties.

Low thyroid, mild hypoglycemia, mild anxiety, difficulty falling asleep and getting back to sleep, mild inattentive type of ADD that is much worse in times of stress (poor focus, mild confusion, difficulty learning), mild problems with physical strength including frequent back or muscle strains and aches.

Mild head injury when head hit bottom of pool duing dive @ age 10. Evidence of this was seen on Spect brain scan.

Nearly fainted during Glucose Tolarance test roughly 20 yrs ago. Hypoglycemia is much improved today with better diet but still needs to eat every 4 hours to avoid poor mood.

Irregular menstrual cycles.

2. Dental history (Wisdom teeth removed and when? Any other extractions. First root canal placed? Braces? First amalgam etc...)

All wisdom teeth removed as young adult, first amalgam around 13 yrs old.

3. What dental work do you currently have in place? What part of the dental clean-up have you completed?

5 amalgam fillings are still present--no cleanup yet.

4. What dentistry did your mother have at any time before or during pregnancy?

Unknown, but she had bad teeth and almost certainly had some amalgams.

5. What vaccinations have you had and when (including flu and especially travel shots)?

Normal vaccinations for child born in early 1960's in USA. One flu shot around age 30.

6. Supplements and medications (including dosages) taken at time of hair test, or for the 3-6 months before the sample was taken?

Armour Thyroid 95mg daily
