Health history for hair test 422

What are your current symptoms and health history?

I had 8 amalgam fillings removed in January of 2009. I was put on a very limited detox protocol, but started feeling great almost immediately. With the help of a doctor who was miles away, I began supplementing with cortisol and naturethroid. I was feeling wonderful. In August I became pregnant with my third child. Chelation stopped. My doctor recommended I stop the cortisol and I started getting heart palpitations on the thyroid medication. I stopped all supplements and only took a prenatal vitamin when I could. I was extremely sick the whole pregnancy. I feel like I have been in a downward spiral ever since. My symptoms are mostly emotional right now. I cry easily, am depressed, and have terrible anxiety. I believe I still have a yeast issue and I am sensitive to most everything that I eat. I have given up trying to figure out what I am allergic or sensitive to. I get a rash and headache when I eat eggs in any form.

My symptoms prior amalgam removal were great.

Dysbiosis Heartburn Thrush (when breastfeeding) Fatigue Achy muscles Joint pain (mostly knees) Low back pain (sometimes severe) Dysmenorrhea Vaginitis Gas Food sensitivities Lock jaw Grinding teeth Headaches

History plus things I have been "diagnosed" with by a doctor:

Childhood: (1976-1994)

All Routine Vaccinations Tubes in ears Fell down the stairs when I was 4 and was hospitalized (bruised the whole left right side of my face) Told I had weak teeth and TMJ Many amalgam fillings placed Antibiotic treatment several times

Dental history (Wisdom teeth removed and when? Any other extractions. First root canal placed? Braces? First amalgam etc...)

I had my wisdom teeth removed in College, so I believe that was in 1998. I had an infection after removal and was put on antibiotics and some serious pain killers. I have had 3 additional extractions, 3 root canals (one of which was removed during my amalgam removal), and my first amalgam filling when I was 8 years old.

What dental work do you currently have in place? What part of the dental clean-up have you completed?

I had all 8 amalgam fillings removed in January of 2009. One tooth with a filling was removed and I now have 7 composite fillings and 2 root canals. The dentist would like to remove the 2 remaining root canaled teeth and put a bridge in my mouth, but I have not done so yet. Two of the teeth that would have to be removed are right in the front and I just can't bring myself to do it.

What dentistry did your mother have at any time before or during pregnancy?

She has amalgam fillings and now has a bridge in the front with all her front teeth removed.

What vaccinations have you had and when (including flu and especially travel shots)?

I cannot find my vaccination records, but I was born in 1976 and received all recommended vaccinations. I received a DT booster in college in 1998. I had a flu vaccine when I was pregnant with my son in 2004. This is the vaccination schedule I found online for 1976
