- Current symptoms: 1-Sciatic pain near the ischial tuberosity. Unable to sit due to pain.
 2-Joint / tendon pain in knees and elbows.
- 2. Dental history: Age 12, first amalgam.

Age 17, 13th amalgam.

Age 20, 2 wisdom teeth removed.

Age 37, one amalgam removed (the wrong way) and replaced w/ non-toxic.

Age 38, remaining amalgams removed and replaced with non-toxic composite (11/2010).

- 8. Other information: Sciatic pain began in 2006 and has gradually increased in pain over time until now, where I can't sit. I've had multiple mri's, blood tests, exams, physical therapy, nerve conduction studies, spinal injections and medications. None of the meds work, and all doctors say I am healthy with all blood tests negative. Even arthritis is negative. After I got my first amalgam replaced in April of 2010, I started getting the joint and tendon pain. The dentist did not use proper precautions for mercury. In November, 2010, I went to a mercury safe dentist to remove all the amalgams. I have since changed my diet, started supplements and read the Cutler amalgam book. My joint and tendon pain is slowly decreasing since the diet / supplement change. My sciatic pain continues strong. I am on DMSA 25mg q 3.5hrs. 3 days on. 4 days off. Will begin LA in February. Hair test shows high Antimony and I'm concerned about that as a possible reason for the joint, tendon issues which I think may be a separate issue from the sciatic pain.
