## **Health history for hair test 467**

Toprol XL, 50 mg. to regulate heartbeat; Topramax, 25 mg. as migraine prevention; Zinc cream to treat eczema or psoriasis. Also, D3, B complex, adrenal and thyroid support, vitamin C, GABA, 5-HTP, L-Tyrosine, multiple vitamin, protein powder, progesterone.

7. What is your age, height and weight?

64 years old, 5 ft. 5 inches height, 160 pounds

8. Other information you feel may be relevant?

Use a Kenmore steam distiller for all my water, take humongworm for parasites. Went to a doctor recommended on frequent-chelation board as Cutler recommended who was very expensive and did nothing but prescribe an anti-depressant and ordered lab tests he knew my HMO wouldn't order.
