Health history for hair test 519

- 1. Trouble focusing/concentrating, convergence insufficiency and related eye problems, brain fog (moderated by Paleo diet), poor reading speed and comprehension, had a very damaged gut but healed it. Had seasonal allergies but healed with allergy shots, diet and healed gut (most of the immune system is in the gut). Symptoms of high-functioning Asperger's Syndrome, never officially diagnosed, moderated with age (ratio of mercury to weight diminished as I grew?). Lacking ambition, disinclined to leave home but will do so without excessive prompting, not very social.
- 2. Wisdom teeth removed at 24 years. No fillings, ever.
- 3. None.
- 4. Unsure. Not much if at all.
- 5. The usual for 1970s, 6 years of allergy shots ending 5 years ago, flu shots for a few of the years I received allergy shots. Allergy shot vials were refrigerated, don't know if they added preservatives, shots didn't add noticeably to symptoms.
- 6. Jigsaw Complete for a few weeks prior to test which unintentionally gave me 75mg ALA twice a day, Jigsaw Health digestive enzymes and probiotics, Butyrex.
- 7. 40, 6'1", 185 pounds
- 8. Healing my gut and fixing my diet significantly moderated symptoms. Two months of 50mg ALA after this test plus the inappropriate 75mg ALA twice a day (corrected) has noticeably improved my eyes, I don't have to lean forward to see my computer screen clearly anymore. I believe that mercury and/or arsenic caused my convergence insufficiency as described in AI and caused my vision to deteriorate from 20/15 after LASIK to 20/30 to 20/40 in successive years until being arrested and partially reversed by vision therapy for CI. Large pupils are an indicator that LASIK is inappropriate, likely that surgeons don't understand that mercury causes enlarged pupils? Improvements from vision therapy didn't stick, likely due to undiagnosed metals. Suspect primary mercury poisoning from broken thermometer at 3 or 4 years, mercury spill cleaned up with vacuum cleaner creating mercury vapor? Suspect arsenic not until 14 years when moved to new city and home 2 blocks off highway, eye and academic problems began a year later. Additional arsenic from probable CCA lumber deck at new construction home, lived there 13 years until 2 years ago. Aging remarkably slowly, as does mother and brother.

- 1. Follow up to test #519 from 10 months ago. Symptoms have diminished, treatment for adrenal dysfunction is more effective now. Eyes are getting better. I think I'm done with chelation?
- 2. Wisdom teeth removed just after college, never had dental fillings of any kind.
- 3. None.
- 4. Possibly a couple of mercury fillings. Uncertain.
- 5. The usual for a 40yo American. A few flu shots several years ago. Allergy shots for 6 years, ending several years ago.
- 6. Magnesium, B100, cod liver oil, molybdenum, acetyl I carnitine, vitamin C, taurine, lithium orotate 5mg, selenium, probiotics, digestive enzymes, Butyrex.
- 7. 40. 6'1". 180 pounds.
- 8. Adrenal dysfunction appears to be my biggest remaining problem. Nutricology ACE was counterproductive. Recently started taking ashwagandha and rehmannia tinctures, and goji berry juice for stressed adrenals (high cortisol, high DHEA). Seems to be helping. Both mercury and adrenal dysfunction hurt the eyes, presenting as convergence insufficiency with poor eye tracking as mentioned in AI. Price diet, thus the weight loss since the last test. Stronger too.
