2) Dental history (wisdom teeth removed? First root canal placed? Braces? First amalgam

Wisdom teeth removed in 20s. First root canal(s) (two teeth) placed at least 25 years ago (not certain when). No braces. First amalgam in teens. Some of amalgams I have currently are at least 20 years old if not older.

- 3) What dental work do you currently have in place? What part of the dental cleanup have you completed?
- 4 Large Amalgams in Place. 5 Crowns, 3 with Root canals. At least one of the root canals has amalgam under it because dentist who placed it said so when placing the crown. The oldest two of the root canal crowns are nickel crowns. Recent extraction of tooth #9 (front incisor) due to abscess with flipper tooth as replacement (for now). Hopefully, about to begin amalgam removal.

6) Supplements and medications (including dosages) taken at time of hair test, or for the 3-6 months before the sample was taken.

Supplemented religiously with magnesium for the last 8 years although not in overly large amounts. Also Epsom's baths. All other supplements -- Vit C, Vit E, EFAs, Vit D, etc. have been sporadic up until a few weeks ago -- so sporadic that probably not a factor concerning the results of this test.

I have been concerned about the copper pipes in my house due to the fact that I am soaking in the baths. My hair test is off the chart with copper. Origin of lead & cadmium, I don't know.
