

Health history for hair test 640

My symptoms:

Restless Leas Syndrome Weepy / bloodshot eyes in the morning (especially after the end of a round) Low energy / fatigue (I need a lot of caffeine to keep going from day to day) contact dermititis / dry and blistering skin on hands (palms) feet sometimes but not often. Major acne as a teen which went into my early 20's I get these grainy blackhead type pimples now which are all over my skin itchy / sensitive skin gas / flatulence body odor low thyroid function (borderline hypothyroid - has been tested) overweight vision blurriness in the mornings tremors / shaky hands bad balance feet turn outwards / wombling gait tinnitis tingling sensations in my brain dizzy spells (not to black out point but can tell a change in consciousness) candida type issues

Dental History/ Work

Amalgam fillings put in my mouth in childhood (7-16). My mouth had a number of issues with them and my body rejected two creating abscesses underneath the teeth resulting in the removal of the teeth. Over the last 4-5 years I have gradually removed the amalgams upon becoming aware of the damage they cause. A root canal was created 2-3 years ago on a lower molar due to the fact that it was the last molar on my right lower side (couldn't remove that one or I would lose the ability to chew on that side. All amalgams were removed by Jan this year. No mercury has shown up in X-Rays. I do have a suspicion that I swallowed a dislodged amalgam piece however in my early 30's when the amalgams started falling apart.

Mothers Dentistry at Birth

My mother had 2-3 amalgams when I was born. I had a very complicated, prolonged birth lasting 32 hours. I was in a humidicrib for 2-3 weeks and doctors were unsure if I would live. I had jaundice badly on birth.

Vaccinations

I would have had the compulsory vaccinations at the time (I was born in 1974 in Australia - Perth). My mum believes the vaccinations caused a number of developmental delays (didn't speak till I was almost 3), I toilet trained the same time as my sister who was a year younger.

Supplements and Medications during the hair test period (3-6 months before)

3-6 months before the hair test I had not heard of the AC protocol and I was attempting to chelate with chlorella and iodine. Recently I have taken up a number of AC's recommendations regarding supplementation after obtaining his Amalgam Illness book.

Other Relavent info

Around the age of 6-7 I also played with liquid mercury from a broken thermometer in my hand. It was in my hand for a good 5-10 minutes as far as I remember. I feel this may be the cause of the contact dermatitis in my hands.
