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Health history for hair test 657

1) What are your current symptoms and health history?

My daughter is chelating for mercury and heavy metals, and has been very sick, so I wanted to have a hair test done to see if there would be anything similar in our genes, as well as if this may shed some light on my leg pain.

I had fillings done as a teenager, in the 1950's. I was also diagnosed with periodontal disease in the 70's, and had my gums cut away.

3) What dental work do you currently have in place? What part of the dental cleanup have you

completed?

I still have 2 crowns and 2 fillings.

4) What dentistry did your mother have at any time before or during pregnancy? My mother got false teeth in her 20's.

5) What vaccinations have you had and when (including flu and especially travel shots)?

Flu shot yearly, hepatitis (required in the fire department where I worked), and those shots required while in the Navy in 1957.

I brush my teeth 3 times a day, use a water pick once a day with mouthwash, and floss twice daily.
