Health history for hair test 771

1. What are your current symptoms and health history?

Anxiety, brain fog, occasional mild depression, difficulty dealing with busy sometimes stressful job, adrenal fatigue, no stamina, weak muscles. I'm 31 years old, issues with anxiety and fatigue started around 15 years ago. Been through the usual process of getting nowhere on the NHS here in the UK.

Testing with a local nutritionist found low cortisol on a 24 hour saliva test, low free T3 on a blood spot thyroid test, and Candida and parasites including Blastocystis Hominis.

Found a private doctor last November who diagnosed me with mercury and other heavy metal toxicity and possible lyme disease (low CD57 cell count - 112)

I had 5 treatments on DMPS IV with this doctor which did improve me, but I've decided to follow the Cutler protocol myself as this is cheaper and I believe safer.

- Dental history (Wisdom teeth removed and when? Any other extractions. First root canal placed? Braces? First amalgam etc...)
 Can't remember when wisdom teeth were removed. Had 2 mercury fillings put in around 14 years old. These were removed 2 months ago by a private dentist who specializes in mercury removal.
- 3. What dental work do you currently have in place? What part of the dental clean-up have you completed?
 I think all the clean up has now been completed
- 4. What dentistry did your mother have at any time before or during pregnancy?

8 or 9 mercury fillings

5. What vaccinations have you had and when (including flu and especially travel shots)?

Can't remember, all the standard vaccinations done by the NHS.

- 6. Supplements and medications (including dosages) taken at time of hair test, or for the 3-6 months before the sample was taken?

 Magnesium 150 every 2-3 days, zinc 20mg per day, X-tend Life multivitamin occasionally although these always give me a bad headache.
- 7. What is your age, height and weight? 31 years old, 5ft 10 inches, 76kg (168lb)
- 8. Other information you feel may be relevant?

 My private doctor told me my mercury levels after DMPS challenge test were the highest he has seen in his clinic (results of this also attached in case of interest)
