Health history for hair test 818

1) What are your current symptoms and health history?

Has suffered ADHD symptoms from early childhood, including lack of focus and substandard short-term memory. Parents met regularly with teachers/counselors/psychologist on how to condition him to be reasonably successful in the classroom. Teachers noticed his inability to focus on anything that did not capture his imagination (such as most school work). Not disruptive as are many similarly afflicted. Rather moody at times, VERY prone to defeatist attitude, depression, negative overreaction/dramatizing, general pessimism. Generally happy/pleasant, but prone to 'going dark' without notice, depending upon conditions.

Several rather dark moles across the crown of his head and just above one ear, most of which have been removed.

Problematic acne; face, forehead, shoulders.

Cannot focus thoughts when in an argument - mind goes completely blank. Dry, course hair.

Irrational anxiety: often unnecessarily nervous.

Very light perspiration.

Nervous picking/biting of fingernails and fingertip skin, lips.

Irrational anger at inanimate objects.

Extremely intolerant of younger children...couldn't tolerate a crying baby in a restaurant when he was a toddler.

Cannot 'let go' of any emotional situation. Example: when scolded, remains angry and depressed sometimes for hours.

Holds grudges very tightly.

2) Dental history (wisdom teeth removed? First root canal placed? Braces? First amalgam etc...)

Currently on second round of braces, well along the way to being completed. No amalgams.

3) What dental work do you currently have in place? What part of the dental cleanup have you completed?
