1) What are your current symptoms and health history?

Inflammation of scalp, dry / brittle hair, hair loss, difficulty speaking, loss of concentration, cold hands / feet, loss of sex drive, fatigue, digestive issues, body acne, floating spots in eye sight (occasional)

2) Dental history (wisdom teeth removed? First root canal placed? Braces? First amalgam etc...)

9 amalgams from childhood to teens, Wisdom teeth removed, 1 root canal 5 years, braces during teens

3) What dental work do you currently have in place? What part of the dental cleanup have you completed?

All amalgams have been replaced with composites (2 years ago)

4) What dentistry did your mother have at any time before or during pregnancy?
